It's only because they choose to make the time, commitment and the extra rehearsals that they were able to perform the gig in the first place.

Quartets that are registered with BHS, SAI, HI, or MBHA have made a commitment to being ambassadors of barbershop harmony and are usually incurring expenses in their striving for excellence. They should have the option to use those funds for betterment of the quartet. However, we are still all under a 501c3 status and even those quartets should donate excess funds to worthy causes.

In no case should funds that come in be used as income to any member of a quartet. Paying expenses is reasonable use.

Discussion of the above wording prompted some thoughts that Nancy volunteered to put into writing. We can review this policy that will be pushed up to the Board after revisions are finalized.
